FIRE LEVY

OFFICIAL LEVY BALLOT
VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT LEVY
MONROE COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA
May 13, 2014

Regular election to authorize levies for the years beginning July 1, 2014, July 1, 2015, July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017 and July 1, 2018 for the purpose of the General Current Expense Fund, according to the order of the County Commission of Monroe County entered on October 2, 2013.

A. Direct services to the following Volunteer Fire Departments in Monroe County, West Virginia, including; Ballard Volunteer Fire Department, Peterstown Volunteer Fire Department, Lindside Volunteer Fire Department, Union Volunteer Fire Department and Alderson Volunteer Fire Department. All of the departments heretofore named, except the Alderson Volunteer Fire Department, will receive approximately \$49,524.00 annually. The Alderson Volunteer Fire Department, which has a much smaller coverage area than the other departments in Monroe County, has agreed to accept \$5,000.00 annually from levy funds.

1. To purchase, and maintain firefighter's personal protection equipment including; bunker coats, bunker pants, firefighting gloves, self-contained breathing apparatuses, self-contained breathing apparatuses cylinders, self-contained breathing apparatus masks, insurance premiums for self-contained breathing apparatuses and personal alert systems.

\$40,000.00

2. To pay premiums for general liability insurance and worker's compensation insurance for firefighters.

\$43,094.00

3. To pay for education and training for volunteer firefighters as required by WV Fire Marshall's Office and the WV State Fire Commission.

\$20,000.00

4. To purchase, maintain and repair the necessary fire and rescue equipment needed to respond to emergency calls.

\$20,000.00

5. To pay the fire department's utility bills and maintain current fire department facilities.

\$20,000.00

6. To purchase, repair and maintain apparatus \$40,000.00

That the approximate amount for said purpose, after making due allowance for delinquencies and exonerations, is approximately \$203,094.00 annually, and the total approximate amount to be expended during the term of this levy is \$1,015,470.00

That the proposed additional rate of levy in cents on each class of property shall be as follows.

Class I:	2.04 cents
Class II:	4.08 cents
Class III:	8.16 cents
Class IV:	8.16 cents

INSTRUCTION TO VOTERS: Those favoring the additional levies select "FOR THE LEVIES", those against such levies select "AGAINST THE LEVIES".
