

Monroe Commission Holds February Meeting

The Monroe County Commission met on February 4, 2015 at 9:00 am at the Courthouse. Commission President Clyde Gum, Jr. called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation.

The County Commission voted to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Board of Education. This MOU outlines the responsibilities of each entity in reference to the training, purchasing of equipment and the paying of the salaries of two of the three Prevention Resource Officers until April 24th, when the officer graduate from the academy.

Tim Wilson, 911 Director, appeared before the County Commission for the purpose of providing an update of the 911 Center. Wilson said the center received 162 law enforcement calls for the month of January 2014 and 205 EMS calls and 49 fire calls. Wilson then provided the annual call report for the center. He said in 2014 the center dispatched 1,757 law enforcement calls, 2,578 EMS calls and 469 fire related calls.
