



## NEW RECYCLING SCHEDULE

### BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 7<sup>TH</sup>

The Monroe County Solid Waste Authority is expanding its recycling program to give you even more opportunities to recycle your household items!

The bin will be available at the following locations and days from **9:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. the following day**

<b>Every Friday</b>	Park	Peterstown

And <b>Saturday 8 am – noon</b>		

No bin service November 25, December 24<sup>th</sup> or January 31<sup>st</sup>. Bad weather schedule is the same as area schools.

### General Rules for Proper Recycling

Remove lids from plastic containers, liners from boxes, anything that isn't paper from newspaper, magazines & catalogues. Try to flatten everything as much as possible. It is not necessary to remove labels from anything!

Separate and prepare your clean, dry items as follows and place them in the proper marked opening in the bin, or take them to HAM Sanitary Landfill, 304-753-9470. There is no charge at any of our locations.

## RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

### Cardboard

Corrugated, Cereal, Cracker boxes, etc.  
**NOT** heavily waxed cardboard like milk or juice cartons

### #2 Plastic Jugs

Milk, Shampoo, Bleach, Detergent, Etc.

### #1 Plastic Bottles

Soda Pop, Salad Dressing, etc.

### Loose Newspaper

Remove rubber bands, plastic sleeves, strapping, twine, etc.

### Loose Magazines & Catalogues

Put **office paper, junk mail & envelopes** in a bag and place in this compartment

### Aluminum & CLEAN Food Cans

Bag these separately but place in the same compartment

**REMEMBER** - Leave CLEAN aluminum cans, food cans and office paper in separate bags in the bins. Everything else should be emptied from your bag.

### THIS IS NOT A GARBAGE BIN!

Garbage will contaminate the recycling you have worked so hard to prepare. Excessive contamination will also result in discontinued service. **REPORT** anyone you see disposing of their household waste in this bin by calling 304-466-0695. **We will prosecute to the full extent of the law.**
